

Bakersfield Town Regular Select Board Meeting
Monday, December 23, 2019

Meeting was called to order at 7:01pm by Josh Goss.

Members in attendance: Lance Lawyer (chair), Sam Cribb, Josh Goss, Gary Denton

Members absent: David Houston

Public residents/guests present: Julian Desnoyers, Mac Newitt, Tami Brennan, Kathy Westcom

Motion made by Sam to accept Dec. 9th minutes, seconded by Gary and approved by vote 4-0.

Julian Desnoyers voiced concern for the maintenance and safety of upper Waterville Mountain Rd. near his residence. He said that he had lived there for 32 years and his neighbor, Gary Booska, has plowed and Julian, has placed sand on the road, but that this year the road has been worse. The Select board acknowledged that this year there have been extenuating circumstances and remembered informing Julian, when he decided to build his residence there, that the town closed upper Waterville Mountain Rd. for the winter months and wouldn't be plowing during that time. There is a sign to that effect at the bottom of the hill, informing travelers, "Road Closed for Winter Months." However, Mac said that Marc tried to get up there today and lay some sand, and once the road gets fixed up, they would be up there again.

John Young called the Select board to inform them that he is opposed to the town investing or spending money on the Lost Nation/Goat Path bridge.

Sam motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:21pm, seconded by Gary and was approved by vote, 4-0.

The Select board will meet on Dec. 30, 7:00pm, to sign warrants and close out the finances for 2019.
