1. Consent Agenda

a. Previous Minutes

2. Visitors

a. Barry Domina-NWSWD

- i. Starting May 28th, the solid waste site will no longer require all recyclables to be sorted. We will still have paper and cardboard separated

but the other items such as plastic, aluminum, glass, tin, etc. will now all go into a single collections container.

- ii. Barry made a site visit to a possible alternative location for the solid waste collection activity.
- iii. The Select Board will need to approach the land owner regarding the possible use of the land and details around that usage.
- iv. If the land is acquired, there will need to be enough time provided to NWSWD to gather funds for capital improvements and preparing the site to support the solid waste site.
- v. Brain and/or David will approach the land owner to begin discussions.
- vi. The site location behind the Bakersfield Elementary School is, at this time, not a possibility mainly due to the fact that the Town does not own the land.
- vii. The Select Board brought up some alternative solutions that might be considered going forward should we need to explore options. One of those possible solutions is “fast trash”. The truck arrives in the morning of collection day and leaves in the afternoon. This would allow for collection of just household trash and recyclables. This might be an interim Solution until we find a new site.

3. Road

a. Road Report

A new bill was submitted for survey work completed at the Gravel Pit. Brian recommended that we hold off paying this bill until the Selectmen are completely satisfied with the work performed.

4. Board Business

a. Appointments for open positions/recurring positions (ongoing until filled)

b. ATV Ordinance Review

Kim is to send the revised ordinance to David with the insurance liability additions included. 25,000 for a single and 50,000 for two or more deaths covered and 10,000 for property damage per crash.

c. New Copier Info Quotes

Brain made a motion to have Kathy, Vera and Kim make a final decision on the selection of a copier to meet the needs of the Town Clerk, Treasurer and other town entities. The Select Board approves either choice, to purchase the equipment outright or to lease. All approved and the motion passed.

Plouff’s Monuments will submit a formal quote to add 10 names to the war monument, correct the spelling on one name, and for a full cleaning.

Brain asked if Kathy would contact the land owners of the “Arena” and inquire as to his involvement with the current ATV usage concerns. Is he aware of the usage, is he concerned about it and does he approve the usage of his land for ATV activity.

Kim will also follow up regarding the Rutland Town Resolution that was signed by the Bakersfield Select Board and emailed to Rutland
