Executive Session - There may be times during the meeting whereby the board must make a motion to enter executive session to discuss certain confidential matters. The board has the authority to decide who remains for the executive session discussion. The board may enter executive if the discussion falls into any of the following categories: Contracts; Labor relations agreements with employees; Arbitration or mediation; Grievances; Pending or probable civil litigation or a prosecution, to which the public body is, or may be a party; Confidential attorney-client communications made for the purpose of providing professional legal services to the body; Negotiating or securing of real estate purchase or lease options; Employment or evaluation of a public officer or an employee – A disciplinary action against a public officer or employee; A clear and imminent risk of peril to the public safety; Discussion or consideration of records or documents that are not public documents.
